

TTaltimeter

From x11-basic



The altimeter shows in very large Letters the actual height above earth WG84 geoid, as it is reported by the GPS receiver. A tendency arrow indicates if you ascend or descent. Also a profile of the heights over distance of the latest track is shown as a moving graph. The resolution is about 1 m, precision is about 30 m.

Download

- The package: TTaltimeter-1.01-bin.zip (<http://www-cip.physik.uni-bonn.de/~hoffmann/TTconsole/TTaltimeter-1.01-bin.zip>)

Install

Unpack the package (zip file) and move the contents to your tomtom Directory just as they are. Thats it. The icon for **TTaltimeter** should appear in the setting menu.

Release Notes

Version 1.00 is just a start. Now we need ideas to improve the display. Since it is written in X11-Basic, maybe YOU(!) want to improve it yourself. It is very simple: You just need to modify TTaltimeter.bas.

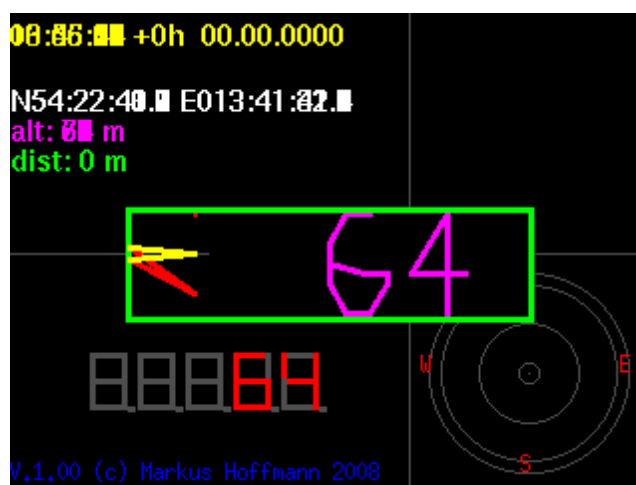
